Behavior Reward/Discipline System SUMMARY

TIME OUT Center

If a child misbehaves (hits another child, disrespect, inappropriate language, etc.) they will write their name on our "TIME OUT" chart outside the director's office under the appropriate day. They will then go to our "Time Out Center" during Centers, Outside play, etc. Children's time-out period will be based on their age (i.e. a 10yr old will have a 10 minute timeout, 5 yr old will have 5 mins, etc).

Behavior Reward

On Fridays during summer camp, to reward and positively reinforce good behavior, every child that had not had a time-out throughout the week will get a special treat, such as ice cream, candy or Popsicle after our afternoon snack.

Tattle Box

We will have a "Tattle Box ", in which the kids can at any time write down a tattle they may have against a fellow classmate. Every Friday, we take the "tattles" that have been submitted and use them as teaching tools (no specifics) through role playing some conflict resolution situations. We will be able to discuss the correct ways to deal with issues they have with others and let the kids work on different solutions to those problems. This will allow the kids the opportunity to be heard while at the same time letting them weigh out what is really worth "tattling" about and coming up with ways to help them address different situations and be able to handle them better in the future. This will hopefully help them learn how to deal with bullying and tell the difference between a "BIG deal" and a "not so big deal".

Christian Education Summary

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, the Elementary Age will have Christian Education class for 25mins.

This school year, the Elementary Age After School Program will be using "Grow Together Now" and "Most Important Bible Lessons for Kids About Loving Each Other".

Below is a description:

With these curriculums, we will focus on equipping kids with the character qualities they need to become the person God created them to be. Children will explore character qualities in memorable Bible lessons that are rooted in Scripture and reinforce God's foundational plan for a fruitful Christian life. Also includes DVD clips with engaging videos that reinforce what kids learn. With these lessons, you'll introduce kids to:

- Forgiveness—Trusting God to help me love others who hurt me.
- Peacemaking—Getting along with others.
- Servant's Heart—Thinking of others before I think of myself.
- Humility—Seeing myself the way God sees me.
- Kindness—Treating others as beloved creations of God.
- Cooperation—Working together to accomplish a goal.
- Loving each other as God loves us.

Each week on **Wednesday** for 25mins, the kids will participate in a community service project which will sometimes include crafts. Possible community service projects: greeting cards for a nursing home, goodie bags for the homeless, placemats for Meals on Wheels, and more.

Special Seasonal Lessons, Crafts, & Christian Movies/Shows will be used to supplement our Christian Education throughout the school year.
